

## HOW TO MAKE A BIRD FEEDER

## **Materials:**

- Tissue Paper Roll
- Hole Punch
- Yarn or twine
- Birdseed

- Peanut Butter, Lard, or Honey
- Plastic or Butter Knife
- Paper Plate

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Use a hole punch to punch holes into either side of one end of the craft roll.
- 2. Pour a little birdseed onto a craft plate so it covers the bottom of the plate.
- 3. Use a butter knife to spread on peanut butter (or lard or honey).
- 4. Roll the coated craft roll in the birdseed so the birdseed sticks to the roll.
- 5. Take 8-12 inches of yarn or twine and feed it through both ends of the punched holes. Then tie the ends together.
- 6. Hang the bird feeder in your backyard!

## **Did You Know:**

- The smallest bird egg belongs to the hummingbird and is the size of a pea.
- A woodpecker can peck up to twenty times a second.
