Designed for residents of Union County, this easy reference guide on the county's waste and recycling services tells how to properly prepare your recyclables and dispose of other special wastes.

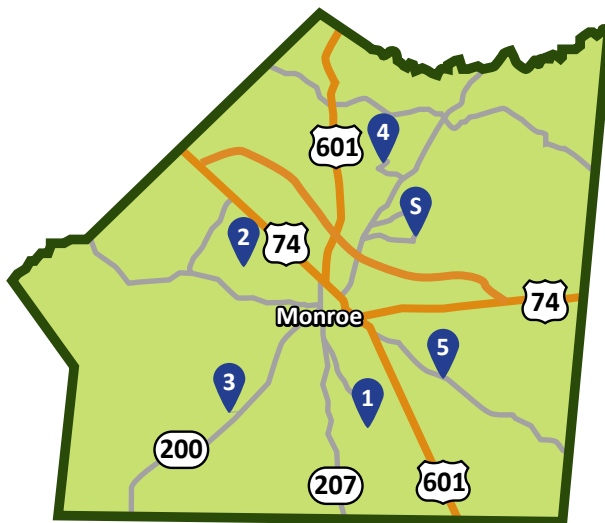

## CONTAINERS

Bottles, tubs, jugs, jars, cans and cartons



No caps, lids or pumps

Empty and rinse

## PAPER

Paper products and cardboard



Flatten cardboard

## GLASS

Bottles and jars



No caps, lids or pumps

Empty and rinse

## KEEP THESE OUT!

- Aerosol cans
- All batteries (car, lithium, etc.)
- Ceramic items
- Clamshells/take-out containers
- Clothing or textiles
- Diapers

- Disposable cups (plastic and paper)
- Electronics
- Food-tainted items
- Hazardous waste\*
- Household glass (windows, mirrors, glass dishware and Pyrex)

- Medical waste
- Plastic bags/wrap
- Scrap metal/wood
- Styrofoam/peanuts
- Tanglers (cords, hoses, wires, etc.)

## ALSO ACCEPTED

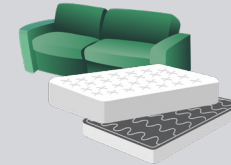
The following items are also accepted for recycling or proper disposal at the Solid Waste Management Facility (SWMF) or the centers. For additional information, see the site attendant.



Construction and demolition material (SMWF only)



Used motor oil and filters (All centers)



Bulky furniture (SMWF only)



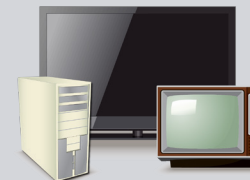
Car batteries and tires - 5 tire limit (SMWF only)



Scrap metal and large appliances (SMWF only)



Leaves, pine straw, brush, grass, small tree limbs (SMWF only)



Electronics (1-4 centers and SMWF only)



Bagged household trash (All centers)
